Tombstone High School FFA and Local 4-H Programs

Summary

The Hereford NRCD has been a supporter of Tombstone High School agriculture program for many years. Due to the SARS-CoV-2 restrictions, much of the planned use for the funds was delayed until 2021-2022 school seasons. Limited advancement in the school's welding program was achieved while the Board of Supervisors reached out to the San Pedro Spirits 4-H Club to discuss how the District may be able to assist the youth in 4-H. Through this contact, an animal tattoo kit was donated to the Club and discussions are ongoing for future collaboration in 2021 and 2022 to support the eight 4-H Participation Pathways for youth engagement programs.

Importance

This program is an essential investment in the local FFA and 4-H student programs. District funds provide extra funding for the agriculture students so that they can accomplish classroom and outdoor activities that they would not otherwise be able to do. For example, welding equipment, classroom materials, clothing, greenhouse and livestock assistance.
